## **UN RESOLUTION 2117**

For those of our members who are unaware of UN Resolution 2117, one portion of this resolution calls for "member states to support weapons collection, disarmament". The treaty would have effectively placed a global ban on the import and export of small firearms. It would have affected all private gun owners in the US and had language that would have implemented an international gun registry on all private guns and ammo.

In a 53 to 46 vote, the Senate narrowly passed a measure that will stop the US from entering into the UN Arms Trade Treaty.
