APPLESEED PROJECT

As we did last year, we will again host an Appleseed event on August 3rd and 4th starting at 8:30 a.m. This is a marksmanship program open to all ages and skill levels for both men and women. Shooting begins at 25 yards and can go out to longer ranges. .22 rimfire rifle is all that is needed, but you're welcome to bring centerfire rifles also. Loaner rifles and shooting mats are available on a limited basis. It is likely you will go through 400 to 500 rounds of ammunition over the entire event.

The fees for the event are as follows:

- Adult male : \$80 for two days, \$50 for one day.
- Ladies: \$40 for two days, \$20 for one day.
- Under 18: \$20 for two days, \$10 for one day.

During the program, you will hear the true stories of the events of April 19, 1775, when marksmanship met history and our American heritage began.
